Situated within the heart of the Tri-Cities metropolitan area of the Eastern Washington desert, Pasco is the largest city in the million-acre Columbia Basin Irrigation Project. As an agricultural center, Pasco's infrastructure plays a major role in moving diversified agricultural products into domestic and world markets.

Pasco is nestled at the convergence of the Columbia, Snake and Yakima Rivers aesthetic and recreational charisma surrounded by natural beauty. Its diverse culture, thriving economy; public transportation; major medical facilities and award winning educational services. Pasco provides a diverse palette for economic and community resources.

Located with Interstate 82, U.S. Highway 395 and State Route 12 links Pasco to transcontinental highways, not to mention the Port for waterways, rail, and the Washington's third busiest airport for service! Demographics

The Tri-Cities region has a population near 312,000 and is ranked in the top ten fastest growing metropolitan area, and the top 10 of high technology communities in the nation. The 300 days of sunshine and the abundance of water located in the area, including the Columbia, Yakima and Snake Rivers makes this desert community rich in agricultural production and a popular recreation destination.

Pasco has experienced rapid residential growth over the past decade, with population reaching an estimated 80,180 in 2022. Its setting within the Tri-Cities metropolitan area and the related transportation attracts further growth over the next 10-20 years. The metropolitan economy is largely influenced by the Hanford Nuclear Reservation, the nation's largest nuclear waste cleanup mission managed by the Department of Energy. Pasco's economy is substantially influenced by agriculture (raw production as well as value-added processing) and distribution (railroad, barge, air and highway).
